BY-LAW

Number 95-95

To authorize the acquisition
of the YMCA Property on
McMurchy Avenue

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is in the interest of the City to purchase the existing YMCA facility and property on McMurchy Avenue to provide a community recreation centre for Secondary Planning Areas 15 and 16.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The purchase of the lands described in Schedule A attached hereto at a price not to exceed \$1,800,000 is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an agreement of purchase and sale in a form approved by the City Solicitor together with all other documents that in the City Solicitor's opinion are necessary to effect the purchase of the said lands.
