BY-LAW

Number 95-2010

To amend Traffic By-law 93-93 by amending the Consolidated Text

WHEREAS Subsection 11(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001 permits a local municipality to pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 93-93 as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:
 - Section 46 (1) of the Traffic By-law 93-93 is repealed and replaced by the (1) following:

PARKING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY

- 46. (1) No person shall park or leave a motor vehicle:
 - on private property without the consent of the owner or (a) occupant of the property;
 - on property owned or occupied by a public authority or (b) any local board without the consent of the public authority or local board, as the case may be;
 - on a municipal laneway, provided suitable signs (c) prohibiting parking are erected and maintained;
 - (d) if a parking space has been designated by lines painted on the surface of the parking area on private property, no person shall park any vehicle in such a manner that is not wholly within the area designated as a parking lot space.
