# BY-LAW

*Number* 96-79

RESTRICTING THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES  
PASSING OVER A BRIDGE

WHEREAS subsection 12 of section 77 of The Highway Traffic Act (R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 202) provides that:-

The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a bridge may by by-law limit the gross vehicle weight of any vehicle or any class thereof passing over such bridge;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to limit the weight of vehicles passing over bridges in the Corporation of the City of Brampton

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:-


1. The limiting maximum weights on bridges at the following mentioned locations shall not be exceeded by a vehicle or combination of vehicles or any class thereof, whether empty or loaded, operating over the bridge;


<u>BRIDGES</u>	<u>MAXIMUM PERMISSIBLE WEIGHT</u>
2nd Line East 0.7 miles south of Steeles Avenue	15 tonnes
Churchville Road 0.05 Miles East of Creditview Road	10 tonnes
5th Sideroad 0.5 miles west of 9th Line East	15 tonnes
3rd Line West Lot 2, Conc. 4 Eldorado Bridge	15 tonnes
Hallstone Road 0.25 miles East of Mississauga Road	11 tonnes

2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 77 (13) of The Highway Traffic Act.

3. This By-law shall not become effective until approved by the Ministry of Transportation and Communications and until a notice of the limit of weight permitted, legibly printed, has been posted in a conspicuous place at each end of the bridge.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council

<u>BRIDGES</u>	<u>MAXIMUM PERMISSIBLE WEIGHT</u>
2nd Line East 0.7 miles south of Steeles Avenue	15 tonnes
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2. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 77 (13) of The Highway Traffic Act.





