BY-LAW

Number 96-89

To amend By-law 316-83, as amended which licences, regulates and governs the owners and drivers of tow trucks

WHEREAS pursuant to paragraph 1 of section 227 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended) and section 142 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O., c.440, as amended) Council has passed a By-law licensing and regulating the owners and drivers of motor vehicles used for hire or any class or classes thereof;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable to amend the by-law with respect to the definition of "tow truck";

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The definition of "tow truck" as defined in section 49 of the by-law is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"tow truck" means a motor vehicle for hire for the towing or conveying of vehicles."

2. The following provision shall be added to the by-law:

"50. Reference to the act of "towing" or to a "towed" vehicle in any provision of this by-law shall be deemed to include the conveyance of same."
