BY-LAW

Number 94-2009

To approve the expropriation of certain lands for the purpose of a road widening (Castlemore Road)

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, at its meetings of September 24, 2004 and March 26, 2008, enacted By-laws 312-2004 and 67-2008 to authorize the expropriation of certain lands and interest in land for the purpose of widening Castlemore Road between The Gore Road and Regional Road 50;

AND WHEREAS notice of Council's intention to expropriate the said lands were served on all persons with an interesting the lands and in accordance with the provisons of the *Expropriations Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.E26, as amended;

AND WHEREAS none of the persons with an interest in the lands as identified in Schedule "A" to this by-law requesting a Hearing of Necessity under the provisions of the *Expropriations Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. The expropriation of the lands in the City of Brampton described in Schedule "A" to this by-law for the purpose of a road widening of Castlemore Road is hereby approved.
- 2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and where appropriate to register on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as approving authority all notices, plans, certificates and other documents and forms required by the <u>Expropriations Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990, c.E26, as amended, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, in order to complete the expropriation of the said lands.

READ a **FIRST**, **SECOND** and **THIRD TIME** and **PASSED** in Open Council this 25th day of March, 2009.

^{*} The temporary grading easement is to allow access to the subject lands with workers, material and equipment for the purpose of regrading, shaping and restoration works on the subject lands for a time period running from the date of registration of the expropriation plan until the date of completion of the widening of Castlemore Road between The Gore Road and Regional Road 50 as certified by the City of Brampton Commissioner of Works and Transportation for a maximum period of three years.
