

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 96-2011

being a By-law to authorize the purchase of property rights from Settimo Beghin and Amalia Beghin for the widening of Countryside Drive from Torbram Road to 500 meters east of Goreway Drive

The power of a municipality to acquire land under the *Municipal Act*, 2001 or any other Act includes the power to expropriate land in accordance with the *Expropriations Act*. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a by-law be enacted authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute, on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, an Agreement of Purchase and Sale together with all other documents necessary to effect the acquisition of the property rights needed for the widening of Countryside Drive (Torbram Road to 500 meters east of Goreway Drive) with Settimo Beghin and Amalia Beghin at current market value plus additional fees and taxes. Said agreement to be on terms and conditions acceptable to the Commissioner of Works and Transportation and in a form of agreement acceptable to the City Solicitor.
