



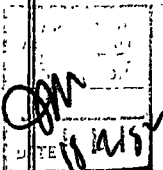
To adopt Amendment Number 99

Planning Area.




1. Amendment Number 99 to the Consolidated Official Plan of the City of Brampton Planning Area is hereby adopted and made part of this by-law.
