# BY-LAW

**Number** 100-98

To authorize the expropriation of the property known municipally as 80 Main Street North

Paragraph 58 of section 207 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.M.45, as amended, authorizes councils of all municipalities to pass by-laws for acquiring, erecting, altering and maintaining, inter alia, places of recreation and amusement, arenas and auditoriums;

Section 191 of the Municipal Act authorizes the council of every corporation for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation;

The Corporation of the City of Brampton is the owner of the Heritage Theatre auditorium located at 86 Main Street North, Brampton;


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is appropriate and in the interests of the corporation to expand the Heritage Theatre auditorium and has determined that additional land will be necessary to accommodate the expansion.

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The expropriation of the lands and premises described in Schedule A hereto for the purpose of providing land to accommodate the expansion of the Heritage Theatre auditorium.
2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as expropriating authority, all notices, applications, advertisements and other documents required by the Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.E.26, in order to effect the expropriation of the said lands.
