A By-law to authorize the expropriation of certain lands in the City of Brampton

WHEREAS it is the intention of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, as the Expropriating Authority, to expropriate those lands shown in Schedule 'A' attached hereto for public purposes.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- That the expropriation of the lands described in Schedule 'A' attached hereto is hereby authorized.
- That the Clerk is hereby authorized to sign notices and advertisements on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton as required by The Expropriations Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 154, and amendments thereto.

BY-LAW

No. 105-79

A By-law to authorize the expropriation of certain lands in the City of Brampton.

SCHEDULE 'A'

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises, situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton in The Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Township of Chinguacousy in the County of Peel) and being composed of Part of Lot 9 in Concession 2, East of Hurontario Street, and more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point on the north-east limit of Plan M-176, distant 1,100 feet measured north-westerly along the north-easterly limits of Plans M-177 and M-176 from the most westerly angle of Block Q, Plan M-165;

THENCE south-easterly 1,100 feet along the north-easterly limits of Plans M-176 and M-177 to the most westerly angle of Block Q, Plan M-165;

THENCE north-easterly along the north-westerly limit of Plan M-165 a distance of 1,010 feet to a point;

THENCE westerly in a straight line from the last mentioned point a distance of 1,390 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement.
