BY-LAW

Number 105-2008

To amend Interim Control By-Law 265-2005, An Interim Control By-Law applicable to Part of the Area Subject to By-Law 270-2004, as amended.

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. By-Law 265-2005 as amended by By-Law 232-2006, is hereby further amended as follows:

1.1 Section 3 is amended by adding after the words: "The establishment of any new use or the expansion of any existing use, on any land, in any building or in any structure is prohibited", the following:

"except as provided for in Section 3.1".

1.2 The following is added as Section 3.1:

"3.1 The lands located at 1195 Martins Boulevard in the Village of Churchville and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption From Interim Control By-Law 236-2005, as amended by By-Law 105-2008 as outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall permit an addition at the front of the existing house not to exceed 225 square feet in area."

1.3 Schedule A is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this By-Law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 23rd day of April, 2008.

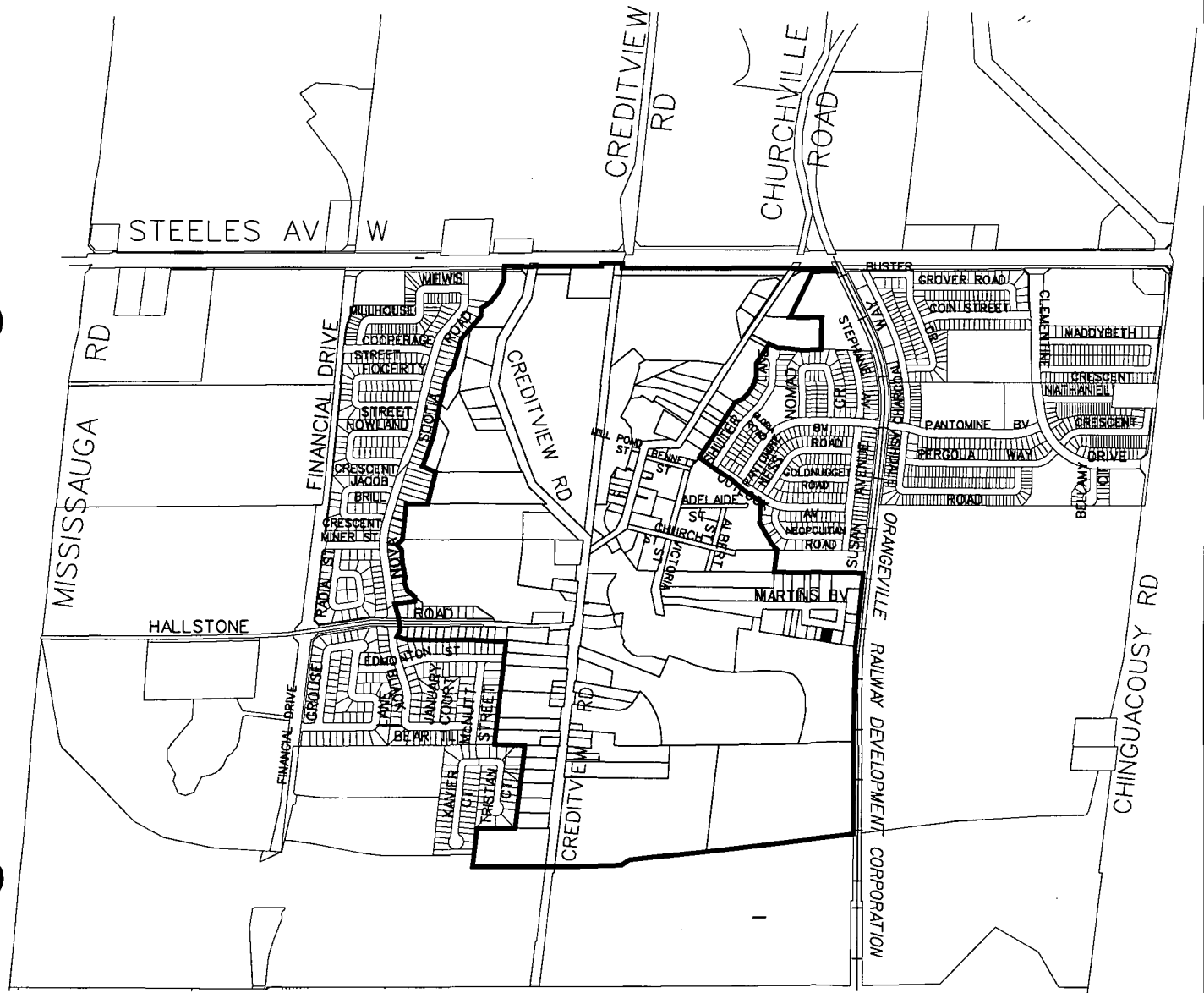

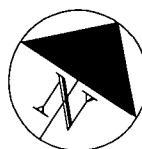



DECLARATION


I, Kathryn Zammit of the Town of Caledon, in the Region of Peel, hereby make oath and say as follows:
