



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 106-2005

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1630

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of creating maintenance easements, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands:

City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:

Lots 78 to 91, 94 to 127, 130, 131, 134, 136, 137, 146 to 149, 151 to 154, 156 to 176, 178 to 191, 193, 194, 196, 197, 201, 202, 204, 205, 207, 210 to 213, 215 to 225, 227, 231, 239, 241, 242, 245 to 252, and Blocks 258 and 259 on registered plan 43M-1630.

- 2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the Planning Act, this by-law shall expire on April 11, 2006.
