To amend By-law 62-81 (the Procedure By-law).

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

 By-law 62-81 is amended by deleting therefrom section 22 and substituting therefor the following section 22:

Section 22

- Subject to section 22.1 (2), a Council meeting shall not carry on past 11:55 o'clock in the afternoon, local time, and shall at that time, by operation of this rule, without requiring a motion or resolution, be adjourned unless on a motion to continue at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at the meeting and voting vote to continue the meeting until all matters of business have been dealt with.
 - (2) Where a motion to continue is not made or, if made, not approved by at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at the meeting and voting, the meeting of Council:
 - (a) shall not be adjourned until
 - (i) a motion to adjourn the meeting to another date and time, other than 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon, local time, on the date following the meeting, if presented to Council, has been dealt with by the Council, and
 - (ii) all the by-laws arising out of business dealt with by the Council at that meeting to the time of adjournment have been presented to and dealt with by the Council, and
 - (iii) a by-law confirming the proceedings of that meeting to the time of adjournment has been presented to and dealt with by the Council, and

- (b) shall be adjourned to 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon, local time, of the day following the meeting, or to another date and time agreed upon by Council, to deal with the remaining business set out in the agenda of the meeting being adjourned.
- (3) Notwithstanding the order of business set out in section 11, at 11:45 o'clock in the afternoon, local time, discussion on the matter then being considered by the Council shall be suspended to allow a motion to continue the meeting or a motion to adjourn the meeting to another date and time, other than 7:30 o'clock in the afternoon, local time, on the date following the meeting, or both, to be presented to and dealt with by the Council.
