To appoint an officer to
serve summonses under the
Summary Convictions Act in
respect of parking offences

WHEREAS paragraph 45 of section 208 of the Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended) provides that a municipality may pass by-laws for appointing such officers and servants as may be necessary for carrying into effect the provisions of any by-law of the Council, and for prescribing their duties;


AND WHEREAS it is necessary to appoint an additional officer to serve summonses under the Summary Convictions Act in respect of parking offences.

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Walter Heatherington, of the City of Brampton is hereby appointed as a by-law enforcement officer for the purposes of:
By-law 205-79 (which designates private roadways as fire routes, and prohibits parking thereon),
By-law 206-79 (which regulates parking on private and municipal property),
By-law 317-81 (which regulates certain off street parking of vehicles operated by or conveying physically handicapped persons),
By-law 193-83 (which regulates traffic and parking), and
By-law 63-87 (which regulates the parking of vehicles on municipal parking lots),
all as amended.

2. This appointment shall be solely for the purpose of serving summonses under the Summary Convictions Act, in respect of the By-laws referred to in section 1, and shall not be deemed to bestow any additional powers of enforcement with regard to these By-laws or any other By-law for the Corporation of the City of Brampton.
