**Number** 110-2000

To declare surplus and authorize the transfer of land.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS** as follows:


1. The land described in Schedule A to this by-law is hereby declared to be surplus to the needs of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.

3. The Mayor and the Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the transfer of the land in a form approved by the Commissioner of Legal Services and City Solicitor, together with all other documents that, in the City Solicitor's opinion, are necessary to effect the said transfer of land.
