WHEREAS the Lieutenant Governor in Council has designated the institutions listed in Column One of Schedule "A" attached to this By-law as correctional institutions pursuant to Section 304 subsection 2 of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Ch. 284 as amended, and the Minister of Correctional Services has determined the number of resident places in each such institution to be those listed in Column Two of the said Schedule, pursuant to the said

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to levy an amount upon the said institutions, as authorized by the said subsection.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the amount listed in Column Three of Schedule
"A" being the product of 50 multiplied by the number
of resident places in the correctional institution
listed in Column One opposite thereto, be and is
hereby levied upon the correctional institution so
listed, in the sum of Twenty-Two Thousand, Four
Hundred and Fifty (\$22,450.00) Dollars.

The said amount shall become due and payable on the 3rd day of July, 1978.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 23rd day of May, 1978.
