



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 103-2006

To authorize the purchase of certain lands from Canadian Tire Corporation, Limited for road widening purposes.

Section 6 of the *Municipal Act 2001* authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The purchase of the lands described as part of Lots 2, 3 and 4 Concession 7, Northern Division designated as Parts 1, 2, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 on Reference Plan No. 43R-28586, Parts 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 on Reference Plan 43R-30192, Parts 30, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 42 on Reference Plan 43R-30305, for road widening purposes and Parts 31 and 32 on Plan 43R-30305 for a traffic signal easement together with a hydro easement over Part 18 on Plan 43R-30192 and Parts 26, 29, 43 and 44 on Plan 43R-30305, in the City of Brampton, for the purposes of widening Goreway Drive, is hereby authorized.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between vendor, Canadian Tire Corporation, Limited and purchaser, The Corporation of the City of Brampton, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said land.
3. The funds for the acquisition shall be taken from capital project account # 024020 – Land Acquisition.
