BY-LAW NUMBER 114-75


A By-law to amend By-law Number 861 as amended by By-law Number 877 as amended to permit the erection of an integrated educational and recreational facility on part of Lot 8, Concession 2, East of Hurontario Street.


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

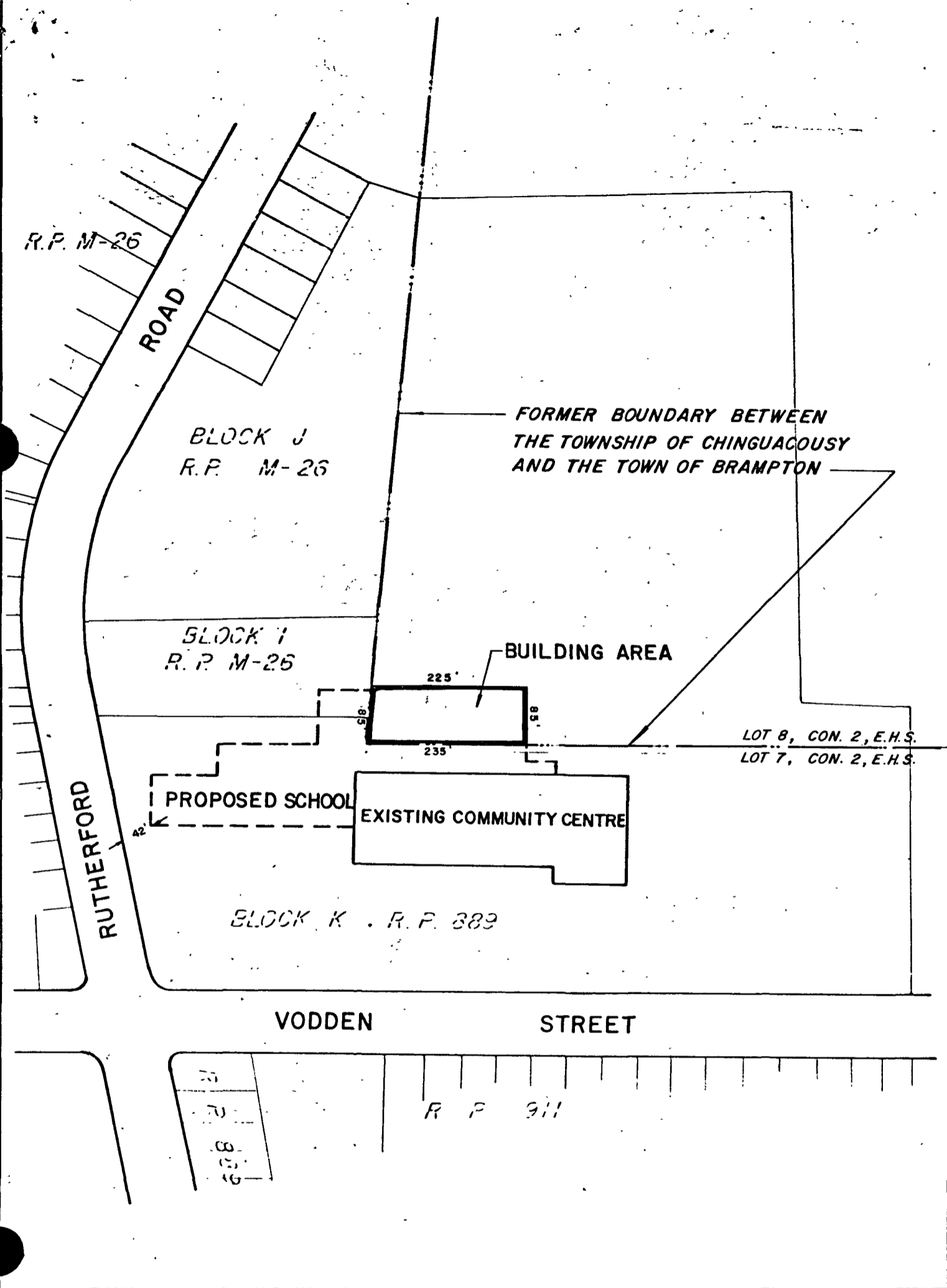
1. Notwithstanding any of the provisions set out in Section 20A of By-law Number 861, of the former Township of Chinguacousy as amended, a building or part of a building containing integrated educational and recreational facilities may be erected within a building area as shown on Schedule 'A' hereto attached and the provisions of the said by-law relating to minimum side yard and minimum rear yard shall be deemed not to apply to such building.
2. This By-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.

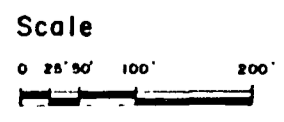
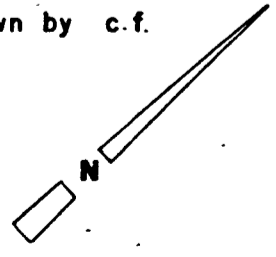

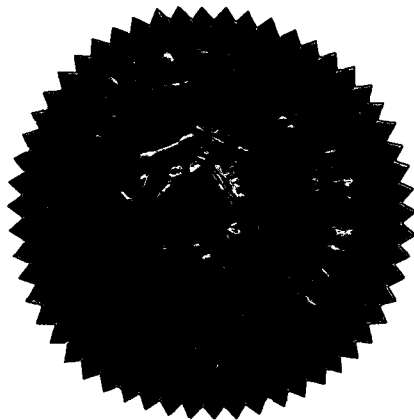
