BY-LAW NUMBER 115-75

A By-law to prohibit or regulate the use of land and the erection, use, bulk, height and location of a building on part of Block K, Registered Plan Number 889 and on Block I, Registered Plan M-26, in the City of Brampton.


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Notwithstanding any of the provisions of former Town of Brampton By-law Number 2920 and By-law Number 1827, as amended, a building or part of a building containing integrated educational and recreational facilities may be erected within the building area shown on Schedule 'A' hereto attached and the provision of the said by-laws relating to minimum side yard and minimum rear yard shall be deemed not to apply to such building.
- 2. This By-law shall not come into force and effect unless and until approved by the Ontario Municipal Board.


