WHEREAS section 23 of the <u>Line Fences Act</u> (R.S.O. 1980, c. 242, as amended) provides that the said Act's provisions respecting the apportionment of the costs of a line fence and the enforcement thereof do not apply in a municipality where a by-law passed under paragraph 20 of section 210 of the <u>Municipal Act</u> (R.S.O. 1980, c. 302, as amended) is in force;

AND WHEREAS the said paragraph 20 of section 210 of the Municipal Act provides that a municipality may pass by-laws for determining how the cost of division fences shall be apportioned;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The cost of a division or line fence between land owned by The Corporation of the City of Brampton and land of any other owner shall be apportioned so that the City is responsible and shall pay for 5%, and the other owner 95%, of the said cost.
- 2. The cost of a division or line fence where neither of the properties involved is owned by The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall be apportioned in accordance with the award of the fenceviewers made under and in accordance with the Line Fences Act.
- 3. Any apportionment or award made pursuant to the provisions of this by-law shall be enforced in the manner provided in the Line Fences Act.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 21st day of June , 1982.
