

CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW NUMBER 117-75

TO PROHIBIT THE SOUNDING OF ANY ENGINE
WHISTLE AT CERTAIN HIGHWAY CROSSINGS OF
THE CANADIAN NATIONAL RAILWAY IN THE CITY
OF BRAMPTON

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and advisable that this by-law be passed:

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the sounding of any engine whistle in accordance with the provisions of Section 248 (i) of the Railway Act, in respect of the following highway crossings within the limits of the City of Brampton is hereby prohibited:

(a) West Street, Pedestrian crosswalk, M.P. 15.69
Halton Subdivision, C.N.R.

This prohibition to be in effect between the period of July 1st 1975 and September 1st 1975.

2. This by-law shall come into force if and when approved by an Order of the Railway Transport Committee of the Canadian Transport Commission.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME and finally passed in Open Council this 23rd day of June, 1975.
