To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-764 (Paul and Joyce D'Orazio)

WHEREAS subsection 49(5) of the <u>Planning Act, 1983</u> has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 49(7) of the <u>Planning</u> Act, 1983, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans of parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- Subsection 5 of section 49 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, <u>1983</u> (S.O. 1983, c.1, as amended) does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
- 2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.
