BY-LAW

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1031 and Registered Plan 43M-1032

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the <u>Planning Act</u>, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plan within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans of parts thereof as are designated in the by-law:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

- Subsection 5 of section 50 of the Planning Act, does not apply to the land that is described in Schedule A to this by-law.
- This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by the Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of June, 1992.
