# BY-LAW

Number 121-2005

To authorize the execution of a Letter of Understanding to Provide  
Funding to the Brampton Historical Society for the 2006 Doors  
Open Brampton Event

**WHEREAS** subsection 107(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* S.O. 2001, c.25 states that

Despite any provision of this or any other Act relating to the giving of grants or aid by a municipality, subject to section 106, a municipality may make grants, on such terms as to security and otherwise as the council considers appropriate, to any person, group or body, including a fund, within or outside the boundaries of the municipality for any purpose that council considers to be in the interests of the municipality;

**AND WHEREAS** The Corporation of the City of Brampton wishes to support the Brampton Historical Society by being a sponsor of the 2006 Doors Open Brampton Event, which is scheduled to take place the weekend of June 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, 2006, as Council considers the Doors Open Brampton Event to be in the interests of the municipality;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a letter of understanding, in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, which will facilitate the provision of \$25,000.00 from the Corporation of the City of Brampton to the Brampton Historical Society, to financially support the Doors Open Brampton Event, June 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> 2006.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this 25th day of April, 2005.
