WHEREAS subsection 107(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25 states that

Despite any provision of this or any other Act relating to the giving of grants or aid by a municipality, subject to section 106, a municipality may make grants, on such terms as to security and otherwise as the council considers appropriate, to any person, group or body, including a fund, within or outside the boundaries of the municipality for any purpose that council considers to be in the interests of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton wishes to support the Brampton Historical Society by being a sponsor of the 2006 Doors Open Brampton Event, which is scheduled to take place the weekend of June 10th and 11th, 2006, as Council considers the Doors Open Brampton Event to be in the interests of the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton enacts as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute a letter of understanding, in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, which will facilitate the provision of \$25,000.00 from the Corporation of the City of Brampton to the Brampton Historical Society, to financially support the Doors Open Brampton Event, June 10th and 11th 2006.
