# BY-LAW

Number 121-2014

To Stop Up and Close and Declare Surplus a portion of the  
Bernadino Street road allowance.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to stop up and close as a public highway, and declare surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton a portion of the street parcel being part of Bernadino Street, Plan 43M-1842, designated as Part 1 on a draft reference plan prepared by Schaeffer Dzaldov Bennett Ltd., referred to as Drawing No. 07-303-09, in the City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, as illustrated on attached Schedule A;

**AND WHEREAS** this portion of Bernadino Street will no longer be required for road purposes, and will serve no other municipal purpose;

**AND WHEREAS** the procedures required by By-Law 160-2004, as amended, have been followed;

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton  
**ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. THAT the portion of Bernadino Street road allowance, having an area of approximately 0.07 acre, as illustrated on attached Schedule A, be stopped up and closed as a public highway and declared surplus to the requirements of the City of Brampton.

**READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED** in Open Council this  
7th day of May 2014.

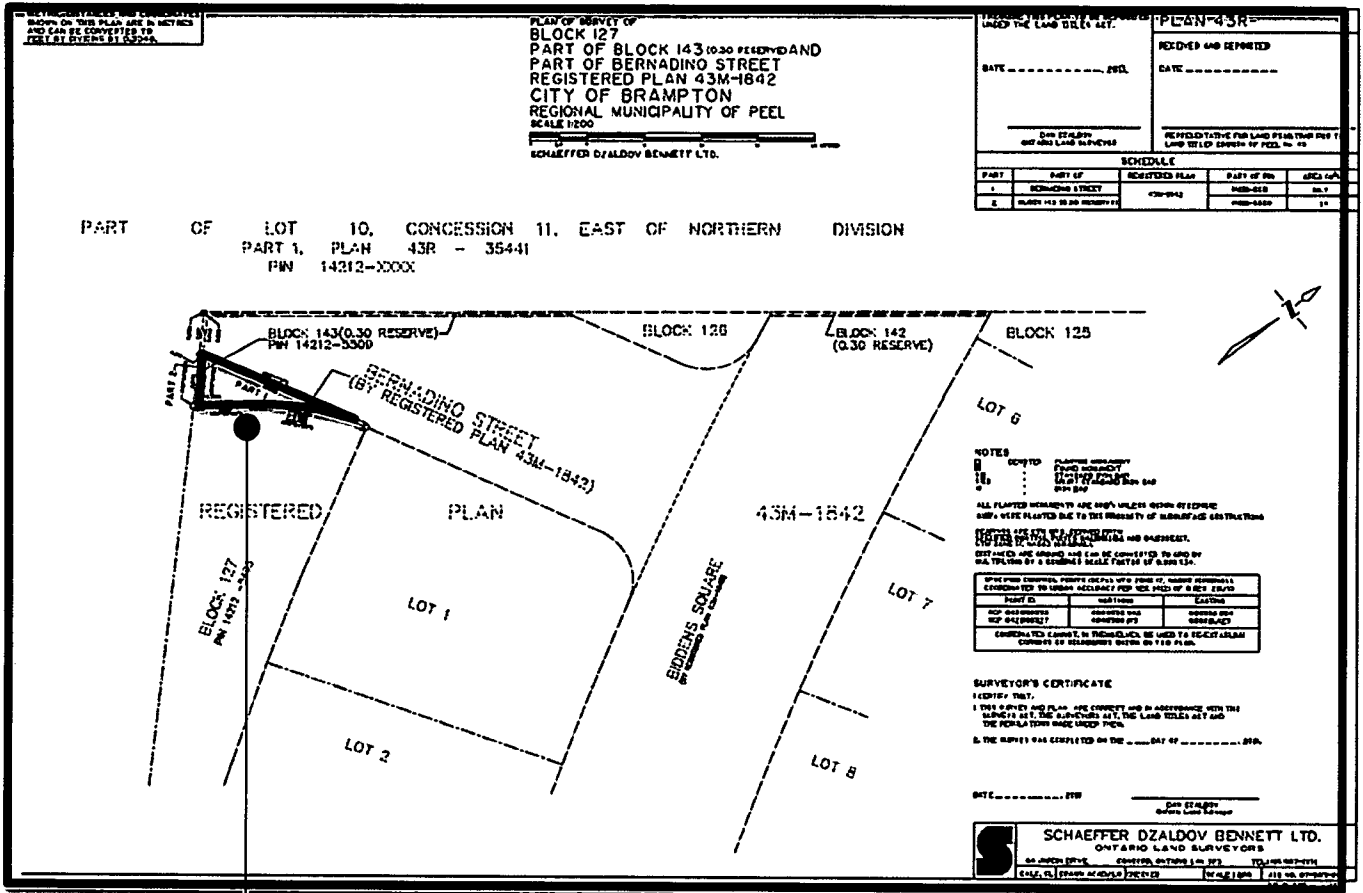
