



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 122-95

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M-1068 and to Repeal By-Law 110-95


WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 c.P.13, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;


AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the council of a municipality may by by-law provide that part lot control does not apply to lands within such registered plans or parts thereof as are designated in the by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. Subsection 5 of section 50 of the Planning Act, does not apply to the following lands:
 City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of:
 - that part of Lot 441, on Registered Plan 43M-1068 designated as Part 1 on Deposited Plan 43R-20969
2. By-Law 110-95 is hereby repealed.
3. This by-law shall come into force upon approval thereof by The Regional Municipality of Peel.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of June, 1995.
