BY-LAW

Number ______ 124-87

To authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$1,157,650.00 for the undertaking of various park redevelopments. OMB E870300

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton

desires to undertake various park redevelopments in accordance with the O.M.B. order number E870300, a copy of which is attached as Schedule "A".

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake various park redevelopments.
- 2. That the Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from the Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$1,157,650.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to the Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 8th day of June, 1987.

THE BOARD ORDERS that this application be granted and that the applicant may proceed with the development programme to the parks as follows:

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(A) Peel Village Park - Phase 2

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- (i) Park Renovations
- (B) Sports Field Lighting ImprovementsEarnscliffe Park, Victoria Park
- (C) Bovaird/Kennedy District Park
- 2. Playground Development Replacement of Playgrounds at Five (5) existing City Parks:

- (i) Gage Park
- (ii) Goldcrest Park
- (iii) Greenmount Park
- (iv) Hilldale Park
- (v) Howden Park

3. Chinguacousy Park - Phase 4 Fire Hydrants

and The Regional Municipality of Peel may issue debentures therefor for a sum not exceeding the lesser of \$1,157,650.00 or the net cost of such undertaking for a term not exceeding ten years, provided that the Councils of the applicant corporation and The Regional Municipality of Peel in exercising any power approved by this order shall comply and conform with all statutory and other legal requirements related thereto.
