


The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

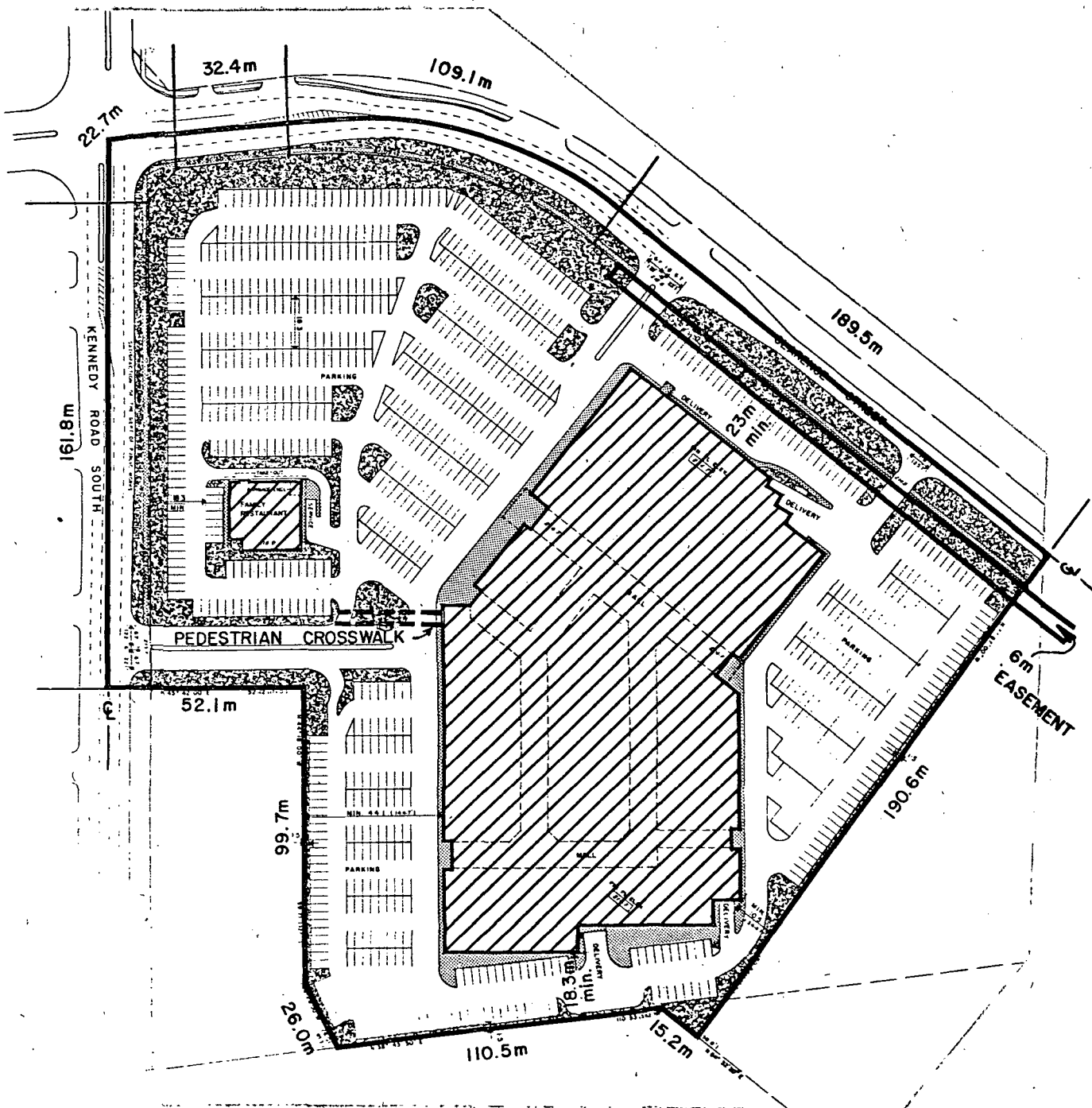




