

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number <u>128-91</u>

To amend By-law 151-88 (part of Lot 9, Concession 1, E.H.S. in the former Township of Chinguacousy)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 151-88, as amended, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by deleting therefrom, section 220 and substituting therefor the following:
 - "220.1.1 shall be used for the following purposes:
 - (1) automobile service station;
 - (2) gas bar;
 - (3) motor vehicle washing establishment;
 - (4) groundwater treatment facility; and
 - (5) purposes accessory to the other permitted purposes.
 - 220.1.2 shall be subject to the following requirements and restrictions:
 - (1) Minimum Lot Width: 35 metres
 - (2) Maximum Building Height: 1 storey
 - (3) Maximum Gross Commercial Floor Area:
 - (a) Kiosk: 20 square metres
 - (b) Motor vehicle washing
 establishment : 290 square
 metres
 - (c) Groundwater Treatment
 building: 30 square metres

- (4) Minimum Landscaped Open Space
 - Minimum width of 3 metres (a) abutting an OS zone; abutting a rear lot line; abutting Williams Parkway and Highway Number 10, except for one driveway opening on Williams Parkway and Highway Number 10.
 - All other cases minimum width (b) of 1.5 metres
- shall also be subject to the requirements 220.1.3 and restrictions relating to the HC2 zone and all of the general provisions of this by-law which are not in conflict with the ones set out in section 220.1.2.
- For purposes of section 220, LOT LINE, 220.2 REAR, shall mean the lot line furthest and opposite the front lot line."
