WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has considered a request from **Sandringham Place Inc.** for a release of easements over the lands described in this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The easement rights over the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby declared to be surplus to the needs of The Corporation of the City of Brampton.
- 2. The releases of the easements over the lands described in column 1 of Schedule A attached hereto for the price set out in column 2 of Schedule A attached hereto are hereby authorized.
- 3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the releases of these easements in a form approved by the Commissioner of Legal Services and City Solicitor, together with all other documents that, in the City Solicitor's opinion, are necessary to effect the said transfers of land and release of easements.
