

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 134 - 2007

To authorize the purchase of certain lands from Orlando Corporation for road widening purposes

Section 6 of the <u>Municipal Act 2001</u> authorizes the Council of every corporation to pass a by-law for acquiring or expropriating any land required for the purposes of the corporation. The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has determined that it is necessary and in the interest of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to acquire the lands herein described for road widening purposes.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. The acquisition of those lands described as Part of Lots 14 and 15, Concession 5 and Part of Lot 15, Concession 6, West of Hurontario Street, City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, designated as Parts 1 through 5 on Registered Plan 43R-29621, save and except Part 2 on Registered Plan 43R-31330, for the purposes of widening Heritage Road and for a nominal consideration, is hereby authorized.
- 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton an agreement of purchase and sale, in a form approved by the City Solicitor, between vendor, Orlando Corporation and purchaser, The Corporation of the City of Brampton, together with all other documents that in the opinion of the City Solicitor are necessary to effect the purchase of the said land.
