



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 134.2009

To prevent the application of part lot control to part of Registered Plan 43M - 1690

WHEREAS subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. c. P.13, as amended, has imposed part lot control on all lands within registered plans within the City;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide that subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to land within such registered plan or plans of subdivision or parts thereof, as are designated in the by-law;

AND WHEREAS, the application for an exemption from part lot control, pursuant to subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, on the lands described below, for the purpose of permitting access from Denison Avenue, is to the satisfaction of the City of Brampton;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act does not apply to the following lands: City of Brampton, Regional Municipality of Peel, being composed of: Part of Block 4 on Registered Plan 43M-1690, designated as Parts 2 and 3 inclusive on Reference Plan 43R-32671.
2. THAT, pursuant to subsection 50(7.3) of the Planning Act, this by-law shall expire at the end of the business day on April 22, 2012.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 22nd day of April 2009.
