BY-LAW

Number 136-82

To temporarily close a portion
of Main Street North

WHEREAS paragraph 44 of section 208 of The Municipal Act (R.S.O. 1980, chapter 302, as amended) authorizes a municipal council to pass by-laws for closing to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis for such period as shall be specified in the by-law any highway or portion of a highway under the jurisdiction of the council for such social, recreational, community or athletic purpose, or combination of such purposes, as may be specified in the by-law;


AND WHEREAS the Board of Management of the Four Corners Improvement Area desires to hold a street dance on a portion of Main Street North on Saturday, July 31, 1982;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That during the street dance being held by the Board of Management of the Four Corners Improvement Area between the hours of 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 31, 1982 and 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 1, 1982, Main Street North from the north side of Queen Street to the south side of Nelson Street shall be closed to vehicular traffic.

2. That between the hours of 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 31, 1982 and 2:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 1, 1982, parking on Main Street North from Queen Street to Nelson Street shall be prohibited.
3. This by-law comes into effect upon approval of the Ministry of Transportation and Communications.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 12th day of July, 1982.


