A by-law to	declare land to for Municipal

WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 47 of <u>The Municipal Affairs Act</u>, R.S.O. 1970, chapter 118, as amended, the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has caused a Tax Arrears Certificate to be registered against land more particularly described in Schedule A annexed hereto (herein called the 'land');

AND WHEREAS the Treasurer of The Corporation of the City of Brampton has complied with all of the provisions of <a href="https://doi.org/10.2016/jhear.201

The COUNCIL of The Corporation of the City of Brampton hereby ENACTS as follows:

The land is hereby declared to be required for the Municipal purposes of The Corporation of the City of Brampton, namely public parkland.

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SCHEDULE A

ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Brampton in The Regional Municipality of Peel (formerly in the Town of Brampton in the County of Peel) and being composed of part of Lot 84 according to a Plan registered in the Land Registry Office for the Registry Division of Peel (No. 43) as Number 635, which said parcel may be more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the south-westerly angle of Lot 84.

THENCE north 10 degrees 25 minutes east a distance of 29.08 feet.

THENCE north 81 degrees 39 minutes 30 seconds east, a distance of 150.93 feet to a point in the easterly limit of Lot 84, distant 46.64 feet measured northerly from the southeasterly angle thereof.

THENCE south 7 degrees 46 minutes east along the easterly limit of Lot 84 46.64 feet to the south-easterly angle of Lot 84.

THENCE south 88 degrees 28 minutes west a distance of 160.96 feet to the point of commencement.
