



THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number 137-83

To stop up, close and sell parts
of Driftwood Crescent and Oleander
Crescent, on Registered Plan M-109

WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton has assumed parts of Driftwood Crescent and Oleander Crescent on Registered Plan M-109 as public highways;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient by The Corporation of the City of Brampton that certain parts of Driftwood Crescent and Oleander Crescent be closed and stopped up, and sold to the owners of the abutting lands;

AND WHEREAS notice of the intention to pass this by-law has been published once a week for four consecutive weeks in the Daily Times and the Guardian, being newspapers circulated in the City of Brampton;

AND WHEREAS the City has given notice to the Regional Municipality of Peel, pursuant to section 49 of the Regional Municipality of Peel Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 440, as amended), and the Regional Corporation has indicated that it does not object to such stopping up;


AND WHEREAS the Council for the City has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this by-law and who applied to be heard;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The parts of Driftwood Crescent and Oleander Crescent more particularly described in Schedule A to this by-law are hereby stopped up and closed.


2. The sale of the lands described in Schedule B to this by-law to the owners of the abutting lands, for the sum of \$2.00 to each owner, is hereby authorized.
3. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents required to complete the sale of the parts of the public highways stopped up and closed by this by-law.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 9th day of May , 1983.
