# BY-LAW

Number 139-2014

A by-law to authorize the use of electronic vote tabulating equipment at the 2014 City of Brampton Municipal Election

**WHEREAS** Section 42(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, provides that the council of a municipality may pass a by-law authorizing the use of vote tabulating equipment for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 47 of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996, as amended*, addresses who may remain in the voting place when the vote is being taken or votes are being counted,

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Optical scan vote tabulating equipment shall be used at all voting locations, including advance vote locations, for the 2014 City of Brampton Municipal Election,
2. In addition to optical scan vote tabulating equipment, touch screen vote tabulating equipment shall be used at some advance vote locations for the 2014 City of Brampton Municipal Election, and may be used at selected locations on Municipal Election Day 2014 as determined by the City Clerk, and
3. A candidate may appoint one scrutineer to remain in the voting place when the vote is being taken or the votes are being counted. If the candidate who appointed the scrutineer is present in the voting place when the vote is being taken or the votes are being counted, the scrutineer may not be present at the same time.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 21<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2014.
