# BY-LAW

*Number* 147-80

To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day.

WHEREAS The Brampton Flower Festival Association represents that it is a corporation incorporated without share capital;


AND WHEREAS the said Association proposes to hold part of its annual exhibition and show on Sunday, the 22nd day of June, 1980;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 6 of The Lord's Day (Ontario) Act, (R.S.O. 1970, C.59, as amended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by the Brampton Flower Festival Association at 499 Main Street South in Brampton, and in respect of all activities provided in connection therewith, including the operation of a "midway" with shows, rides, games and concessions.
2. The activities specified in section 1 of this by-law shall be permitted only between the hours of 1:00 and 6:00 o'clock in the afternoon of Sunday, the 22nd day of June, 1980, but nothing in this section shall in any way limit the time during which the said Association may conduct any aspect of its exhibition and show which is not unlawful under The Lord's Day Act (Canada).


3. The Brampton Flower Festival Association shall conduct the activities hereby permitted in an orderly manner.
