A By-law to authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$635,000.00 for the construction of certain works.


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
WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the construction of certain works as set out in Schedule "A" hereto.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the construction of those projects set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto, at a total estimated cost of \$635,000.00.
2. That the Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of The Corporation to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from The Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$635,000.00 for the aforementioned purpose and to give on behalf of the Corporation to The Royal Bank of Canada a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.

Open Council this 10th day of July, 1978.

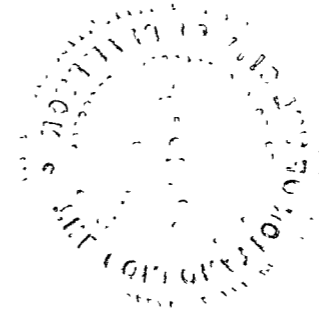

Being a By-law to authorize a capital expenditure in the amount of \$635,000.00 for the construction of certain works.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO.

	<u>ESTIMATED COST</u>	<u>DEBENTURE AMOUNT</u>
1. Construction of a left turn lane on Kennedy Road from Clarence Street to Steeles Avenue, comprising the widening of the existing pavement width, including excavation, granular base, curb and gutter, asphalt paving, sidewalks, sodding, boulevards, traffic light, utility relocations and related works	\$500,000.00	\$280,000.00
2. Reconstruction of Railroad Street from Mill Street to George Street and reconstruction of George Street from Railroad Street to Nelson Street, including storm sewers, excavation, granular base, concrete curb and gutter, asphalt paving and related works	\$135,000.00	\$ 75,000.00
