# BY-LAW

*Number* 149-88

To authorize a Capital Expenditure in the amount of \$122,000.00 for the relocation and erection of a steel building located on the parking lot at Station #3 - 1945 Williams Parkway. OMB E860505.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton desires to undertake the relocation and erection of a steel building located on the parking lot at Station #3 - 1945 Williams Parkway, as well as the supply and delivery of a new cab, chassis and fire body;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. That the Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton shall undertake the relocation and erection of a steel building located on the parking lot at Station #3 - 1945 Williams Parkway, as well as the supply and delivery of a new cab, chassis and fire body in the amount of \$122,000.00.
2. The Mayor and the Treasurer are hereby authorized in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation of the City of Brampton to borrow from time to time by way of promissory note from The Royal Bank of Canada, 1 Main Street North, Brampton, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$122,000.00 for the works described in Schedule A of this by-law, and to give on behalf of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to the Royal Bank of Canada, a promissory note or notes sealed with the Corporate Seal and signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer for the money so borrowed with interest which may be paid in advance or otherwise.
3. By-law 269-86, passed on the 15th day of October, 1986, be and is hereby repealed.
