

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF BRAMPTON

BY-LAW

Number	150-91
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To amend By-law 139-84, (part of Lot 14, Concession 1, W.H.S. in the geographic Township of Toronto)

The council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. By-law 139-84, as amended, and as specifically amended by By-laws 250-87 and 293-87, is hereby further amended:
 - (1) by deleting therefrom, paragraph (3) of section 778.2 thereof and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(3) the number of dwelling units contained within apartment dwellings located within each building area shall not exceed the following:

Building Area A - 164 dwelling units
Building Area C - 587 dwelling units

- (2) by deleting therefrom, paragraph (5) of section 778.2 thereof and substituting therefor the following:
 - "(5) the floor space index for the lands zoned R4B SECTION 778, as shown on SCHEDULE C-SECTION 778 and 779, shall not exceed 2.60".
- (3) by adding thereto, after section 778.2(15) thereof, the following as section 778.2(16):
 - "(16) landscaped open space area for the lands zoned R4B-SECTION 778, as shown on SCHEDULE C-SECTION 778 and 779, shall be provided and maintained on not less than 60 percent of the area lands, provided that in no case shall the landscaped open space area for an individual apartment dwelling on a lot be less than 50 percent."


READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED, in OPEN COUNCIL, this 15th day of July 1991.
