A By-law to amend By-law 1-2002 by
Amending Schedule M-3 which regulates the
licensing of tow trucks and tow truck operators

The Council of The Corporation of The City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule M-3 of By-law 1-2002, the Licensing By-law, is hereby amended as follows:


- 1) By adding to subsection 36 (4), after the words " to at least " the words "3A-40B, C";
- 2) By adding to section 33 as subsection (5) the following:
“(5) take the vehicle to a licensed vehicle facility or the customers home, and when the preferred licensed vehicle facility is closed, the tow truck driver must take the vehicle to its own licensed vehicle facility and may only charge the mileage rate plus the one-day storage fee with no additional charge for a re-tow to the original preferred licensed vehicle facility when it re-opens.”

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in OPEN COUNCIL this 26th day of May, 2003.
