Number 152-76

A By-law to amend By-law Number 37-74, respecting parking meters on the streets within the Corporation of the City of Brampton.

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton deems it expedient and advisable to further amend By-law Number 37-74, being a By-law respecting parking meters on streets within The Corporation of the City of Brampton.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:


- (1) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 37-74 as amended be further amended by the deletion therefrom of the following, under the appropriate columns thereof.


Column 1 <u>Road</u>	Column 2 <u>Side</u>	Column 3 <u>Between</u>	Column 4 Fees & Time <u>Limits</u>	Column 5 Maximum Parking <u>Period</u>
Queen St. E.	South	A point 127' east of the centre line of Main Street S. and a point 50' west of the centre line of Chapel Street	5¢ for 15 min. 10¢ for 30 min.	60 Min.
Main St. S.	West	A point 122' south of the centre line of Queen Street W. and a point 129' north of the centre line of Wellington Street W.	5¢ for 15 min. 10¢ for 30 min.	60 Min.

- (2) That Schedule "A" to By-law Number 37-74 as amended be further amended by the addition thereto of the following under the appropriate columns thereof.

Main Street S. West	A point 216' south of Queen Street W. and a point 104' north of the centre line of Wellington St. West.	5¢ for 15 min. 10¢ for 30 min. 60 Min.
Queen St. W. North	A point 205' west of Main Street N. and a point 257' west of the centre line of Main Street N.	5¢ for 15 min. 10¢ for 30 min. 60 Min.
Queen St. W. South	A point 175' west of Main Street S. and a point 312' west of the centre line of Main Street N.	5¢ for 15 min. 10¢ for 30 min. 60 Min.
Queen St. E. South	A point 213' east of Main Street. S and a point 50' west of the centre line of Chapel Street.	5¢ for 15 min. 10¢ for 30 min. 60 Min.
