
To make it lawful for any person to engage in or be present at certain activities on the Lord's Day

WHEREAS the Kinsmen Club of Brampton Incorporated proposes to hold part of its annual exhibition and show on Sunday, the 22nd day of June 1986;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 6 of the The Lord's Day (Ontario) Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 253, as amended) is hereby declared to apply within the City of Brampton in respect of the exhibition or show conducted by the Kinsmen Club of Brampton Incorporated in the parking lot of Bramrose Square, in the City of Brampton, and in respect of all activities provided in connection therewith, including the operation of a "midway" with shows, rides, games and concessions.
2. The activities specified in section 1 of this by-law shall be permitted after 12:00 o'clock noon, on Sunday the 22nd day of June 1986, but nothing in this section shall in any way limit the time during which the Kinsmen Club may conduct any aspect of its exhibition and show which is not unlawful under The Lord's Day Act (Canada).

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and PASSED in Open Council this 16th day of June, 1986.
