# BY-LAW

Number 152-92

A By-law to divide the Municipality into Electoral Areas under the Education Act and to repeal By-law 55-91

WHEREAS the Education Act permits a Council by By-law to divide the municipality into two or more electoral areas;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That The Corporation of the City of Brampton shall be divided into three electoral areas pursuant to the Education Act for the purposes of election under the Municipal Elections Act for the Public School Board.
2. The areas referred to in clause one (1) shall be as follows:
  - a) Wards 1, 3, 4 and 5;
  - b) Wards 7, 8, 9 and 11;
  - c) Wards 2, 6 and 10.
3. By-law 55-91 is hereby repealed.
