BY-LAW

Number 153-87

To further amend By-law 161-83
(parks by-law)

The Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Clause (d) of subsection 3(3) of By-law 161-83 is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:

(d) Notwithstanding clause (a) of this subsection, no person shall allow an animal under his or her control onto parkland where the parkland contains or abuts a lake where public swimming is permitted.

2. Subsection 4(2) of By-law 161-83 as amended is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:

(2) No person shall:

(a) pollute or contribute to the pollution of a lake, lake area or watercourse; or

(b) feed, or in any other way attract, birds to a lake, lake area or watercourse.
