# BY-LAW

**Number** 157-81

To amend By-law 861 of the former Township of Chinguacousy now in the City of Brampton. (Lots 145 to 152, inclusive, and Part of Block A, of Registered Plan M-104)


The Council of the Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule A of By-law 861, being the Restricted Area By-law of the former Township of Chinguacousy, is hereby amended by changing the zoning designations of the lands shown outlined on Schedule A attached to this by-law from RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE RM1D (RM1D) and GREENBELT (G) to RESIDENTIAL R4 (R4).
2. Schedule A of this By-law is hereby attached to Schedule A of By-law 861 and forms part of By-law 861.

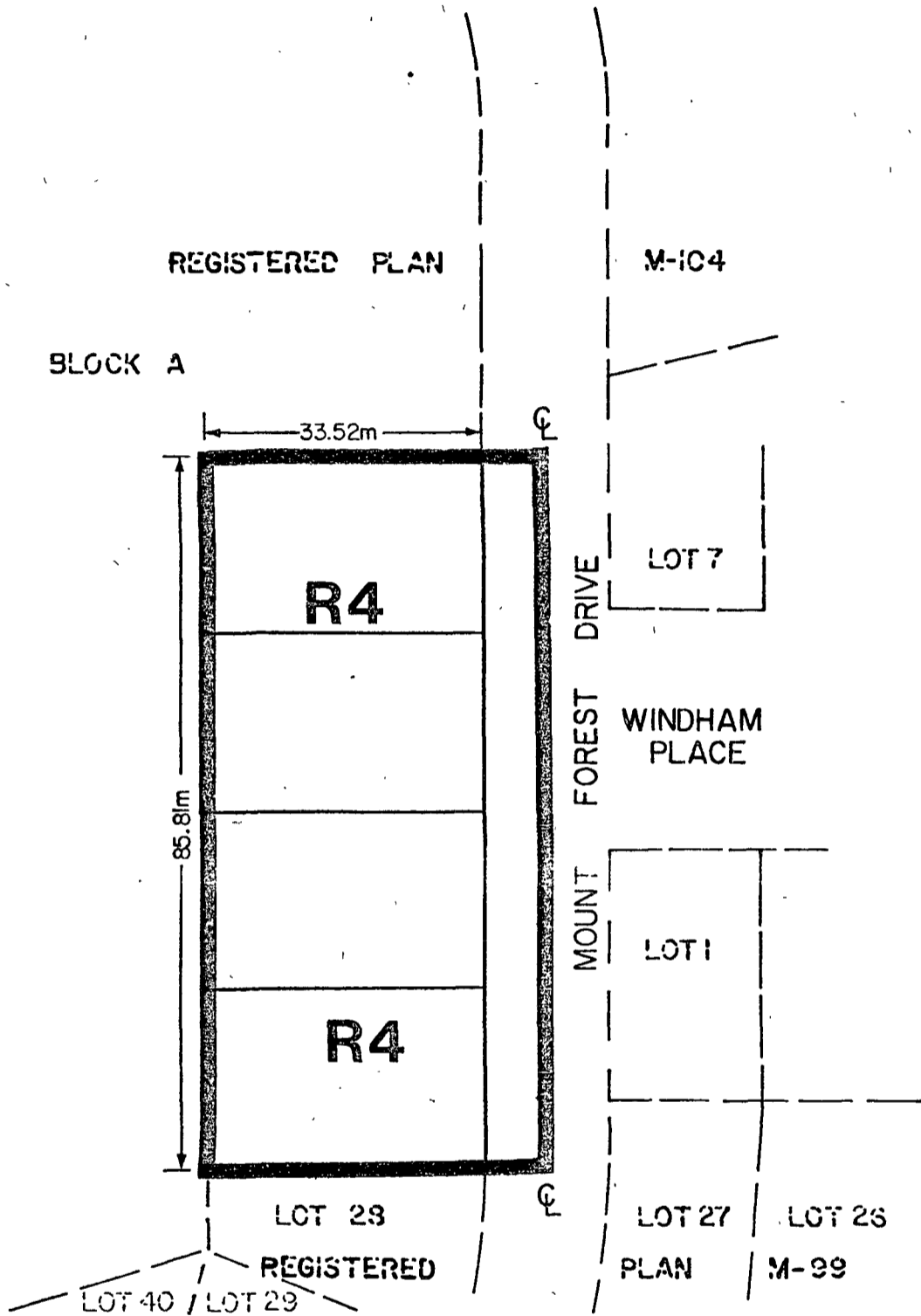

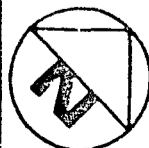


