to establish a Community
Recreation Centre known as
Valleybrook Park

WHEREAS section 2(1) of the Community Recreation Centres Act (R.S.O. 1980, c. 80, as amended) provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, provide for the establishment, maintenance and operation of community recreation centres in accordance with the said Act;


AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the City of Brampton is desirous of establishing a community recreation centre on the lands more particularly described in Schedule A to this by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A community recreation centre, consisting of sports fields; tennis courts; field house and playground to be operated and maintained by The Corporation of the City of Brampton, is hereby established, in accordance with the provisions of the Community Recreation Centres Act, on the lands described in Schedule A to this by-law, such centre to be known as "Valleybrook Park".
2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to implement this by-law.
