# BY-LAW


To change the titles of members of City Council and to amend By-law No. 100-90

WHEREAS section 29 (8) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, C.M-45, provides that the council of a city may, by by-law, change the title "alderman" to "councillor".


NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

1. The title of members of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton (hereinafter called the "City Council") elected as members of City Council only is changed from "Alderman" to "City Councillor".
2. The title of members of City Council elected as members of both the City Council and the Council of The Regional Municipality of Peel is changed from "Councillor" to "Regional Councillor".
3. Section 4 of By-law 100-90 (the Ward Division By-law) is repealed and the following section 4 substituted therefore:
  - "4. City Council shall be composed of a Mayor who shall be elected by a general vote of electors and 16 members elected by wards in the following manner:
    - "4.1 One member, to be called a City Councillor shall be elected in each of Wards 1 to 11 (both inclusive) as described in Schedules A and B to this by-law as members of the City Council only, and;
    - "4.2 One member, to be called a Regional Councillor, shall be elected in each of the Regional Wards as described in Schedule C to this by-law as members of both the City Council and the Regional Council."
4. This by-law shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1992.

READ A FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME, and PASSED in open Council this 13th day of July 1992.
