Number _appoint an alternate representative to the Regional Council

WHEREAS section 12 (6) of the <u>Regional Municipality of Peel</u>
Act, R.S.O. 1980, c. 440, provides as follows:

"(6) In the event that the head of a council of an area municipality is for any reason unable to fulfil his duties as a member of the Regional Council for a period exceeding one month, the council of the area municipality may by by-law appoint one of its members as an alternate representative to the Regional Council who shall act in the place and stead of the head of council during his incapacity, but no such by-law shall have effect for a period longer than one month from its effective date."

AND WHEREAS JAMES E. ARCHDEKIN, the head of the Council of The Corporation of the City of Brampton is, through illness, unable to fulfil his duties as a member of the Regional Council for The Regional Municipality of Peel.

The COUNCIL of The Corporation of the City of Brampton ENACTS as follows:

- 1. That Christopher Gibson is appointed as an alternate representative of The Corporation of the City of Brampton to the Regional Council of The Regional Municipality of Peel.
- 2. This by-law shall take effect on the 1st day of September, 1982 and shall have effect for the month of September 1982.
