

	1.1	Section 3 is amended by adding after the words: "The establishment of any new use or the expansion of any existing use, on any land, in any building or in any structure is prohibited", the following:
		"except as provided for in Sections 3.1 and 3.2".
	1.2	The following is added as Section 3.2:
		"3.2 The lands located at 45 Church Street in the Village of Churchville and referenced as the "Lands Subject to Specific Exemption From Interim Control By-Law 236- 2005, as amended by By-Law 14-2048 outlined on Schedule A to this by-law shall permit a new residential dwelling not to exceed 2,750 square feet in area."
	1.3	Schedule A is deleted and replaced with Schedule A attached to this By-Law.
